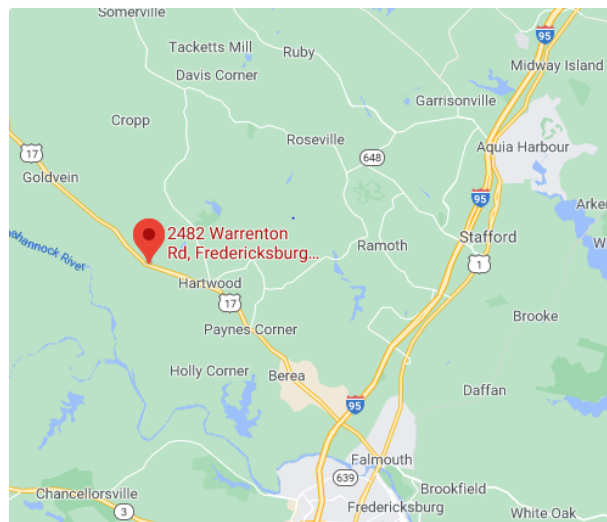
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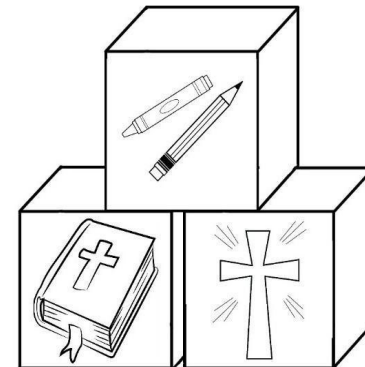

Mission Statement

Richland Baptist Church Preschool is a community dedicated to enriching the lives of children developmentally, morally and spiritually, through academic excellence and a loving Christian environment. Through a variety of fun and educational activities our children will attain the fundamentals of early learning. Cognitive development, fine and gross motor skills, language development, social/emotional development and faith based education, are the core elements of our curriculum.

Our curriculum has been carefully chosen to reflect our Christian values and to meet state and national standards of excellence.

Education

Our curriculum builds on what kindergarten teachers prefer that rising kindergartners know and uses developmentally appropriate practices. All teachers have a degree in education and/or extensive training and teaching experience. All staff are CPR and first aid certified. The Director and several teachers are also EMAT certified.

4-Year-Old Curriculum:

3-Year-Old Curriculum:

2-Year-Old Curriculum:

- Introduction of learning concepts through songs, finger plays, books, and games

- Develop large motor skills through physical education and music

- Taking turns & sharing
- Introduction of colors, numbers, letters

Academic, Physical, Spiritual, and Social Enrichment

Our program provides three twenty minute specials each week for our 3 and 4-year-olds and two specials for our 2-year-olds. Music time introduces 2, 3 & 4 year-olds to basic music concepts, musical instruments and creative movement. Physical education offers our 2, 3 & 4-year-olds the opportunity to develop their gross motor skills and participate in group games. Computer lab is for our 3 & 4-year-old classes and provides students with the opportunity to learn basic computer and fine motor skills. Library gives our students a chance to learn many pre-reading skills and enjoy a variety of books. Our students are introduced to the lessons of the

Bible through Bible stories and related activities each week in the classroom. 3 & 4-year-olds visit our church's sanctuary twice a month for chapel. In chapel, students participate in and learn about worship through songs and stories. These nondenominational, Bible-based lessons are led by the ministerial staff of Richland Baptist and the Preschool Director. At the beginning of each day and before snack, children learn to pray with their teacher, learning thankfulness to God and basic prayer habits.

The children enjoy a healthy snack each day, exciting art projects, theme days, water play days and field trips to nearby locations. Our students also learn to give back to their community through food drives and the St. Jude Trike-a-thon. Friendships blossom and social skills grow through organized and free play, sharing, and taking turns.

Facilities

Located in Richland Baptist Church, the Preschool occupies its own floor and has its own entrance and parking lot. The door remains locked and has a camera entry system. There are four classrooms, a music/PE room, a library/computer lab, administrative office and two bathrooms. There is also a third bathroom in the 2s class that has a diaper changing station and a child size toilet and sink perfect for those in training. Outside the children enjoy our fenced and mulched playground which includes four swings, two slides, and an assortment of climbing and rocking equipment.
